

EDITORIAL

Volume 11 of this Journal has a total of sixteen scientific papers and two book reviews, hence the size of the Journal has remained more or less the same as Volume 10. The number of articles submitted so far however, far exceeds the number submitted at the same time last year. Delays in the editorial process has meant that some articles although submitted early, will of necessity have to appear in Volume 12 of the Journal. For the first time we have book reviews on two books one on "Handbook of Animal Science" and the second on "Cattle embryo transfer procedure". We hope more will be forth - coming in future Volumes.
